LIVING UNDER LAW

Refusing Mail
 Is your mail box cluttered with unsolicited and unwanted mail of the "junk" or "trash mail" variety? If so, your name is probably on one or more mailing lists which are sold or rented to commercial mailers.

If you resent this flood of advertisements and solicitations, what can you do about it?

No one is required to accept such mail. You can hand it back to the postman or mark it "refused" and drop it in any mailbox. The post office will then destroy it or return it to the sender and charge him eight cents for its return if the envelope is marked "Return requested".

Of course, you can request that the sender remove your name from his mailing list, but if he rents or buys the list from others, this is probably useless.

Most of the unwanted mail includes a postage-paid envelope or card for reply. A reply card, blank or filled in, that is returned costs the receiver six cents for ordinary mail and eight cents for air mail. Envelopes returned cost seven and ten cents respectively. Some irate householders return empty envelopes or blank cards to "punish" the recipient by making him pay for useless replies, but this doesn't get his name off the mailing list.

Many people are resentful over this unwanted flood of mail, classing it as invasion of their personal privacy and as annoying as the telephone solicitor. Thus, there are increasing protests and attempts to stem the practice. Caught in the middle, and suffering side effects such as increased postal rates, is the non-commercial and welcome third class mail such as church and lodge bulletins or newsletters.

This direct mail advertising, mostly at third class postage rates, is a big business. It totaled over 18 billion pieces last year, nearly 85 percent of it advertising. This is almost two and a half times the volume of first class mail, only ten percent of which is advertising.

No wonder your mailbox is bursting at the seams!
