



**Robert W. Snyder**

The appointment of Robert W. Snyder, formerly of Elm Valley and Ithaca, N. Y., to the position of Assistant Professor and Extension Economist in Land Use at the University of Minnesota, Saint Paul, Minn. was recently announced by University officials: Snyder, the son of Mr. and Mrs. Herman Snyder of Alfred, received the doctorate of philosophy degree from Cornell University in February. His studies at that institution, largely under the direction of Dr. Howard E. Conklin, Professor of Land Economics, concentrated on agricultural economics, city and regional planning, and public administration and finance. At the University of Minnesota, Dr. Snyder will develop new ex-

tension education programs concerned with a broad range of land use, community development and public finance. He was employed as an Extension Associate at Cornell University in 1963 and at that time served on the Advisory Committee for the Southwestern New York Resource Development Project. He also served on the College of Agriculture Resource Development Committee, where he was instrumental in planning for a series of regional symposia on "Land, Water, People and Economic Growth" in the Spring of 1964, one of the earlier statewide efforts by the Extension Service to stimulate wiser use of natural resources to sustain economic health in rural areas.

Previous to his work and studies at Cornell, Dr. Snyder served as a passenger transport pilot with the Atlantic Division of the Military Air Transport Service. His duties included frequent trips to Europe, North Africa, and the Arctic. He was a member of the crew that accompanied Richard Nixon and numerous correspondents and reporters on the occasion of then Vice-President Nixon's three week tour of six countries of northern and central Africa in 1957. Snyder also participated in the Safe Haven Exercises which brought many Hungarian refugees to the United States after the unsuccessful uprising in that country eight years ago. Now a Captain in the Air Force Ready Reserve Program, he has continued to fly and train at McGuire Air Force Base, New Jersey, the major MATS passenger terminal on the East Coast.

doctoral degree comprised a detailed study of rural non-farm land in Tompkin's County, New York. His findings demonstrated that this important resource is tightly held by a very diverse group of landowners who bid its price up to relatively high levels and benefit from their ownership in a wide variety of ways, most of which have a strong recreational aspect. As a contributor to the property tax base, it was found that it compares favorably with commercial farm land on an acre to acre basis. The thesis, entitled "The Use of Rural Land by Non-farm People" will be edited and published as a College of Agriculture bulletin in the future. An earlier study by Dr. Snyder concerned itself with agriculture and suburbanization in Dutchess County, New York.
