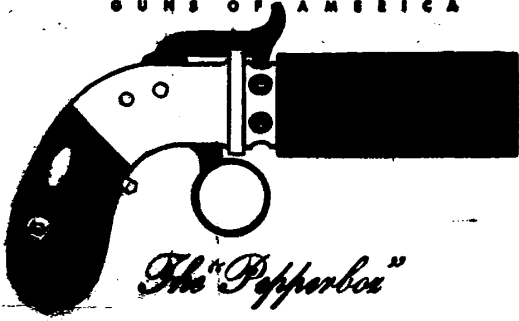


GUNS OF AMERICA

The peppercorn pistol, first made in the 16th Century, had several barrels clustered around an axis so that they could be revolved either by hand, or by action of the trigger. Extremely popular in the United States from about 1836 to 1850, these small heavy weapons were made for close range defense shooting.

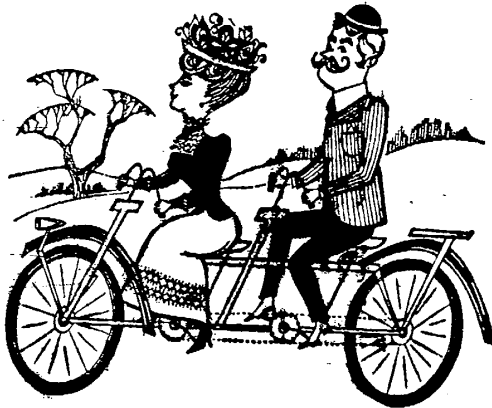
