Greenwood School News

gram. The speech pathologist, Robert K. Kosciwicz, visits the Greenwood School on Monday and Tuesday. He will probably schedule 40 children with moderate to severe speech and hearing problems. The program includes testing diagnosis, and therapy for the speech and hearing handicapped. These children have a variety of difficulties requiring specialized techniques. Schedule permitting, each child is seen twice a week for 30 minutes a session. During this time the child received intensive training in the particular difficulty he is encountering. Parent conferences and home visits are held as frequently as needed to inform each parent of the various procedures he may follow to help in the carry over of the correct responses. Valuable information is received from the parents concerning any background material needed by the pathologist. Reports concerning each child's difficulty, therapy procedures, progress and attitudes are distributed to the parents, teachers and school administrators. The public schools also provide an excellent opportunity for student therapists from Universities throughout the state to gain their practicum in his particular field. Greenwood Central is one of the cooperating schools in Steuben County to be chosen by the State University of New York to receive students for their practicum. During the first nine weeks of school, Miss Suzanne Sprague of R.D. 1, Hornell, is gaining valuable experience in the field of speech therapy and is also fulfilling one of the major requirements of her undergraduate degree work at the State University College at Geneseo. Miss Sprague is in her senior year at Geneseo and has the same working schedule as her supervisor, Mr. Kosciwicz. She visits Greenwood two days a week, Whitesville two days a week, and Belmont one day per week. Miss Sprague will screen all of the students in need of speech therapy, will schedule them for classes, engage in parent conferences and home visits, and provide speech and hearing therapy for the handicapped children.
