

Andover Woman Hurt In Auto Crash

An Andover, N. Y. woman suffered facial and chest injuries Friday, December 12, in a two car collision on Legislative Route 52030 between Genesee and North Bingham, Pa.

Ruth Milligan, 64, a passenger in one of the cars involved was taken by a passing motorist to Dr. E. F. Comstalk, Sr. office and treated. The following day X-rays showed four fractures of the cheek bone.

The accident occurred when a auto operated by Ernest H. Milligan, 65 of Andover, was struck by a car operated by William A. Hickock, 27, of Hamburg, N. Y.

Police said the Hickock vehicle attempted to negotiate a curve and slid on icy pavement into the Milligan car. There was extensive damage to both cars.

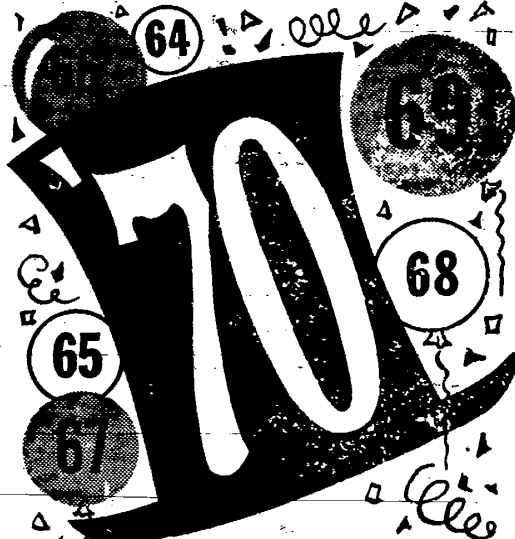
After more X-rays Mrs. Milligan was sent to Buffalo General Hospital Thursday Dec 18th for surgery, returning home Saturday.

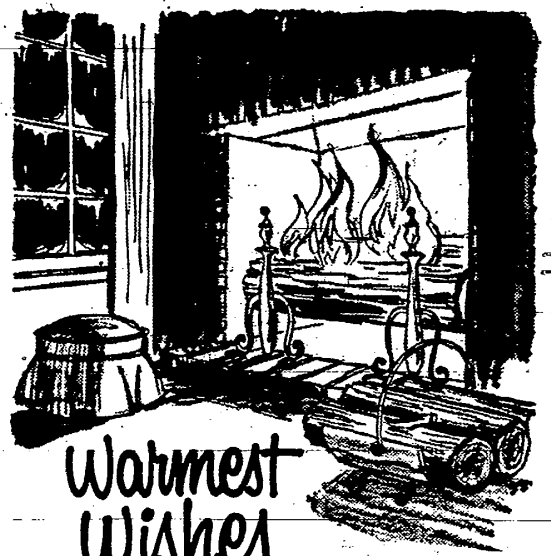
