### Contract Awarded At Ag-Tech

The State University Construction Fund has awarded the Decker Construction Corporation of Elmira a \$2.3 million contract for construction of an Agricultural Laboratory at the State University Agricultural and Technical College at Alfred, Governor Rockefeller has announced.

NII Laboratory Furniture, Inc. of Hicksville, L. I., is the assigned subcontractor to furnish and install Group II Laboratory Equipment coordinated with the general construction and suitable to the needs of the Agricultural Laboratory studies which will include farm management, food distribution, nutrition, fermentation, botany, soils, plant pathology and live animal anatomy.

Paul K. Y. Chen of New York is the architect on this project, which is a brick and aluminum multi-level building having spaces with different functions located on separate levels. The basement floor, at the campus drive level will be used for parking, delivery and building services because, at that level, the sloping land cuts off natural light and ventilation. On the ground floor, plant science laboratories and greenhouses will be located; the first floor plan — at campus core level — shows faculty offices, classrooms, reading room and lounge. The second floor is devoted to animal science farm management and food distribution. The location of plant and animal science laboratories — on the ground and second floors, respectively — contributes to easy flow of traffic in both directions. The completion date for the Laboratory is July 1, 1971.

Current construction under way at Alfred amounts to \$10.7 million. This is part of the State University's multibillion dollar physical development program directed by the State University Construction Fund, headed by Dr. Anthony G. Adinolfi, general manager. Legislation upon the recommendation of Governor Rockefeller to expedite the construction of facilities to meet the State University's Master Plan requirements.

### Worthington To Sponsor On The Job Training Program

Governor Rockefeller has announced that the State Labor Department's Division of Employment has developed an on-the-job training program, under the State Manpower Act, to train 187 Allegheny County persons in skilled occupations. One hundred and thirty-six trainees will be hired from the ranks of the unemployed.

Worthington Corporation, Turbine Division, Wellsville, is sponsoring the program. Training will be in 13 different occupations: billing clerk, clerk typist, cost clerk, detail draftsman, file clerk, metal fabricating inspector, invoice control clerk, layout man and checker, machine operator, manufacturer's service representative, payroll clerk, time analyst clerk and tool programmer. Training will last from six to 26 weeks, depending upon the occupation.

Under the State Manpower Act, the State will reimburse the firm a total of \$88,430 as a portion of the total training costs. The firm will assume the remainder of the training costs, including trainee wages.

The 1969 Legislature appropriated \$15 million for job training under the State Manpower Act.
