Motion to approve these minutes was made by Francis Horan. Seconded by Robert Tamm. Carried by 5 votes of yes.

The minutes of the January 12, 1970 regular meeting were read for approval. Motion to approve these minutes was made by Francis Horan, seconded by Robert Tamm and carried by 5 votes of yes.

Mr. Kessler read the bills for the month of January 1970 amounting to \$6,924.96 plus utilities. Conner Stephens made the motion that these be paid. Francis Horan seconded the motion. Carried by 5 votes of yes.

Cafeteria bills in the amount of \$1,597.75 were read. Lawrence Godown made the motion that these be paid. Robert Tamm seconded the motion. Carried by 5 votes of yes.

The Treasurer's report was read for approval. Lawrence Godown made the motion that the report be accepted as read. Francis Horan seconded the motion. Carried by 5 votes of yes.

The Cafeteria report was read by Mr. Kessler, showing a net loss of \$490.34 for the month of January. A motion was made by Francis Horan to file this report with the minutes. Seconded by Conner Stephens. Carried by 5 votes of yes.

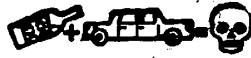

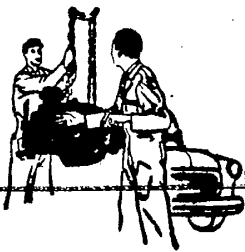
