Section 1. Resolved (if the Senate concur), That subdivision E of section five of article eight of the emistinution be amended to read as follows:

follows:

E. Badebtedness contracted [on or after January first, mineteen hundred sixty-two and prier to January first, ningteen hundred seventy-three,] for the construction or reconstruction of facilities for the conveyance, treatment and disposal of sewage. The legislature shall prescribe the method by which and the terms and conditions under which the amount of any such indebtedness to be excluded shall be determined, and no such indebtedness shall be excluded except in accordance with such determination.

§ 2. Resolved (if the Senate concur), That the foregoing amendment be referred to the first regular legislative session convening after the next succeeding general election of members of the assemble solutions. by, and, in conformity with sec-tion one of article nineteen of the constitution, be published for three months previous to the time of such election.

ABSTRACT OF PROPOSITION NUMBER ONE

Chapter 926 of the Laws of 1970 authorizes an increase of \$20,000,other maximum aggregate amount of State subsidies for the payment of which contracts for low rent housing and urban renewal purposes may be outstanding low rent housing and urban renewal purposes may be outstanding in any one year to a total of \$64,000,000 in any one year, of which amount not more than \$62,050,000 shall be with respect to contracts for payments to assist in achieving and maintaining the low rent character of the projects, all such contracts to be subject to the approval by the Comptroller and the Attorney General as to their form.
