ABSTRACT OF PROPOSITION NUMBER ONE

Chapter 926 of the Laws of 1970 authorises an increase of \$20,000,000 in the maximum aggregate amount of State subsidies for the payment of which contracts for low rent housing and urban renewal purposes may be outstanding in any one year to a total of \$64,000,000 in any one year, of which amount not more than \$62,050,000 shall be with respect to contracts for payments to assist in achieving and maintaining the low rent character of the projects, all such contracts to be subject to the approval by the Comptroller and the Attorney General as to their form.
