James F. Hastings Reports

Washington, D. C. — Rep. James F. Hastings announces that the federal government had made grants for more than \$8 million to aid in construction of water pollution control projects in the 38th Congressional District during the fiscal year which ended last June 30.

The Allegany lawmaker, who re-cently introduced legislation aimed

The Allegany lawmaker, who recently introduced legislation aimed at improving and preserving the purity of the nation's drinking water said figures from the Federal Water Quality Administration showed grants totaling \$8,314,534 had gone to 21 communities for 34 projects with an estimated cost of \$30,934,194.

The 38th Congressional District is made up of Chautauqua, Cattaraugus, Allegany and Steuben Counties plus seven towns in southern Erie County. Here is a partial summary, showing first the estimated cost of the projects, then the amount of the grants in surrounding communities:

Hastings has joined in co-sponsorship of a House resolution commending the officers and men who took part in the abortive "trempt to rescue American prisoners of war in a North Vietnamese POW camp. "The courage displayed in this hazardous and humanitarian mission is typical of the special kind

of valor which has always been a unique characteristic of Amercian fighting men," he said. "It has raised the hopes and spirits of our servicemen in captivity and lets them and the world know that we have not forgotten them and wilh not give up our efforts to achieve their freedom".
