Snowmobiles Must Be Registered By January 1st

Half the snowmobiles in New York State face the fate of being immobilized on January 1st because they have not been registered. That is the expectation of Parks and Recreation's Division of Marine and Recreation's Vehicles

tered. That is the expectation of Parks and Recreation's Division of Marine and Recreational Vehicles, the agency handling snowmobile registration.

It may be that lag in registration is due to the lack of snow, but to date only one quarter of the 120,000 snowmobiles in New York have been registered. This leaves some 80,000 snowmobiles not yet registered and, after January 1st, these may be used only on the property of their owners.

The snowmobile registration unit is presently operating on double shifts, so registration applications received by December 15th will be processed and mailed back to the registrants before the year-end deadline. Applications received after that date will probably be delayed.
