The motion was made by Mrs. Slade to pay the interest only due on New School Bond due on December 15, 1970. The amount of this payment is \$4,050.00. Mr. Tuttle seconded this motion. Carried by 4 votes of yes.

The Treasurer's report was read for approval. Mrs. Slade made the motion that the report be accepted as read. Mr. Tuttle seconded. Carried by 4 votes of yes.

Monthly Cafeteria report was read. Mr. Walker moved to file this report with the minutes of this meeting. Mrs. Slade seconded. Passed by 4 votes of yes.

Mrs. Slade made the motion to raise the School Lunches for students to 30c per meal. Mr. Tuttle seconded. Carried by 4 yes votes.

Dr. Walker moved to adjourn at 9:25. Mr. Tuttle seconded. Carried by 4 yes votes.

Snowmobiles Must Be Registered By January 1st

Half the snowmobiles in New York State face the fate of being immobilized on January 1st because they have not been registered. That is the expectation of Parks and Recreation's Division of Marine and Recreational Vehicles, the agency handling snowmobile registration.

It may be that lag in registration is due to the lack of snow, but to date only one quarter of the 120,000 snowmobiles in New York have been registered. This leaves some 80,000 snowmobiles not yet registered and, after January 1st, these may be used only on the property of their owners.

The snowmobile registration unit is presently operating on double shifts, so registration applications received by December 15th will be processed and mailed back to the registrants before the year-end deadline. Applications received after that date will probably be delayed.

Late applicants are cautioned to be sure that the application is properly filled out and all necessary items included in the bill of sale to avoid the necessity of returning the application for correction, causing additional delay in processing.

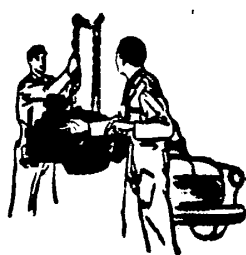
