Check List For Veterans

"Apply for and complete education benefits within eight years of separation."

This is just one of the many reminders in the pamphlet "Check List for Recently Discharged Veterans" according to Mr. James J. McLaughlin, State Veteran Counselor.

The pamphlet, issued by the New York State Division of Veterans' Affairs, serves as a guideline for returning veterans as they may be aware of the many benefits provided for them and for their families by a grateful state and nation.

He urged veterans to pick up copies of the free pamphlet at the local New York State Division of Veterans' Affairs Counseling Center located at the Municipal Bldg., Wellsville, N. Y., on Tuesdays, and at the City Bldg., 108 Broadway, Hornell, N. Y., on Mondays, Wednesdays, Thursdays and Fridays.

A brief visit to the office, he said, will provide an explanation of benefits available as well as assistance and counseling in applying for them.

Mr. McLaughlin urged returning veterans not to put off inquiring about available benefits since many are subject to deadlines set by law.

Aliens Must Register In January

William H. Bartley, District Director of the Immigration and Naturalization Service advises that the Annual Alien Address Report is again under way.

The Immigration official pointed out that the address reports are required by law and willful failure to comply with these requirements may lead to serious consequences.

Forms with which to make the reports are available at all Post Offices and Immigration and Naturalization Service Offices. It is an easy matter to fill out one of the cards and mail it to the same office.

Mr. Bartley added that trained personnel will be on hand in all offices of the Immigration and Naturalization Service to answer any questions the reporting aliens may have regarding immigration and naturalization matters. Sufficient trained personnel are not available to furnish this assistance in all Post Offices.
