**Employer's Federal Unemployment Tax Returns (Form 940)**

Many taxpayers who are receiv-  
 ing Employer's Federal Unemploy-  
 ment Tax Returns (Form 940) for  
 the first time are advised that a  
 change in the law may require  
 their filling out the form announ-  
 ced John E. Foley, Buffalo District  
 Director for Internal Revenue.  
 Employers who have one or  
 more employees for a period of 20  
 weeks or if they have wages paid  
 of \$1500 or more in any calendar  
 quarter of the current or preceding  
 year are subject to the Federal tax.  
 Previously the law required four  
 or more employees for a period  
 of 20 weeks.  
 Foley advised taxpayers who are  
 subject to the Unemployment Tax  
 that the return is to be filed by  
 January 31, 1973.

**Deadline For W-2 Forms Is Jan. 31, IRS Reminds Employers**

The deadline for employers to  
 give employees their 1972 Forms  
 W-2 is Wednesday, January 31,  
 1973, John E. Foley, Buffalo Dis-  
 trict Director for the Internal  
 Revenue Service said today.  
 The form should show earnings,  
 income tax withheld and social  
 security information.  
 Since the employee must attach  
 a copy of the W-2 to his income  
 tax return when filing, Foley urged  
 employers to furnish their em-  
 ployees with W-2's as soon as pos-  
 sible before the deadline of Janu-  
 ary 31. "This would enable the  
 employee to file earlier and re-  
 ceive his refund earlier", Foley  
 concluded.

**Notice To Harborers Or Owners Of Dogs**

Dog Licenses are due on or  
 before January 1st, 1973. They  
 may be obtained at the Town  
 Clerk's Office.

The law requires that dogs be  
 licensed by January 1. Failure to  
 obtain a license subjects the owner  
 to a penalty of \$10.00 and costs and  
 the dog is liable to seizure.

The Commissioner of Health has  
 issued an order requiring all dogs  
 six months of age or over in the  
 County to be vaccinated to prevent  
 rabies. Therefore an applicant for  
 a dog license must present to the  
 Clerk a certificate certified by a  
 duly licensed veterinarian showing  
 that the dog has been so vacci-  
 nated.

To be acceptable, the certificate  
 presented must show that mod-  
 ified live virus vaccine was used  
 within four years immediately pre-  
 ceding the application date, or that  
 killed vaccine of brain tissue or  
 brain tissue origin was used with-  
 in the year immediately preceding  
 the application date.

If your application is mailed to  
 the Clerk, the vaccination certifi-  
 cate must accompany your applica-  
 tion and check.

**Local Law No. 1 of 1973**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN  
 that Local Law No. 1 of 1973 which  
 became effective January 16, 1973,  
 is published pursuant to Section  
 214 (2) of the County Law:  
 A LOCAL LAW ESTABLISHING  
 THE ANNUAL SALARIES OF  
 CERTAIN COUNTY OFFICERS  
 AND THE PER DIEM RATE OF  
 COMPENSATION FOR CORON-  
 ERS

BE IT ENACTED by the Board  
 of Legislators of the County of  
 Allegany as follows:

SECTION 1. Commencing Janu-  
 ary 1, 1973 the annual salary of  
 the County Judge shall be the sum  
 of Thirty Thousand Five Hundred  
 Dollars (\$30,500.00).

SECTION 2. Commencing Janu-  
 ary 1, 1973 the annual salary of  
 the Director of Planning shall be  
 the sum of Fourteen Thousand  
 Dollars (\$14,000.00).

SECTION 3. Commencing Janu-  
 ary 1, 1973 the annual salary of  
 the County Superintendent of  
 Highways shall be the sum of  
 Fourteen Thousand Dollars (\$14,-  
 000.00).

SECTION 4. Commencing Janu-  
 ary 1, 1973 the annual salary of  
 the County Attorney shall be the  
 sum of Fourteen Thousand Dol-  
 lars (\$14,000.00).

SECTION 5. Commencing Janu-  
 ary 1, 1973 the annual salary of  
 the County Treasurer shall be the  
 sum of Twelve Thousand Seven  
 Hundred Seventy-Five Dollars  
 (\$12,775.00).

SECTION 6. Commencing Janu-  
 ary 1, 1973 the compensation for  
 County Coroners shall be at the  
 rate of Thirty Dollars (\$30.00) per  
 diem in the performance of their  
 official duties.

SECTION 7. This local law  
 shall take effect on the date it is  
 filed in the office of the secretary  
 of state.
