 Local Law No. 1 of 1973  
 NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Local Law No. 1 of 1973 which became effective January 16, 1973, is published pursuant to Section 214 (2) of the County Law:  
 A LOCAL LAW ESTABLISHING THE ANNUAL SALARIES OF CERTAIN COUNTY OFFICERS AND THE PER DIEM RATE OF COMPENSATION FOR CORONERS

BE IT ENACTED by the Board of Legislators of the County of Allegany as follows:  
 SECTION 1. Commencing January 1, 1973 the annual salary of the County Judge shall be the sum of Thirty Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$30,500.00).  
 SECTION 2. Commencing January 1, 1973 the annual salary of the Director of Planning shall be the sum of Fourteen Thousand Dollars (\$14,000.00).  
 SECTION 3. Commencing January 1, 1973 the annual salary of the County Superintendent of Highways shall be the sum of Fourteen Thousand Dollars (\$14,000.00).  
 SECTION 4. Commencing January 1, 1973 the annual salary of the County Attorney shall be the sum of Fourteen Thousand Dollars (\$14,000.00).  
 SECTION 5. Commencing January 1, 1973 the annual salary of the County Treasurer shall be the sum of Twelve Thousand Seven Hundred Seventy-Five Dollars (\$12,775.00).  
 SECTION 6. Commencing January 1, 1973 the compensation for County Coroners shall be at the rate of Thirty Dollars (\$30.00) per diem in the performance of their official duties.  
 SECTION 7. This local law shall take effect on the date it is filed in the office of the secretary of state.

The County of Allegany does hereby assume the liability to save harmless and protect its County Clerk and employees of the County Clerk's Office from financial loss arising out of any claim, demand, suit or judgment by reason of alleged negligence of said County Clerk or employees, provided such act was committed in the discharge of their duties and within the scope of their employment.
