IRS Receives Price Complaints

During the past few days, the Internal Revenue Service in Buffalo has received a number of complaints concerning increase in the price of milk at various stores around the area. Under the terms of the Economic Stabilization Program of wage and price controls, the price of raw milk is exempt from controls.

Nevertheless, once this raw product is pasteurized or processed into such items as butter and cheese, the price that can be charged has to be justified by the basis of the merchant's historical price mark-up on his costs.

For example, if a store paid its supplier \$24 for a quart of milk and historically marked-up its cost by 10%, then it could sell the milk for no more than \$26. All fractional cents equal to or greater than 1/2 cent must be rounded up to the next penny; all fractional cents less than 1/2 cent must be rounded down to the nearest penny.

This rule applies even though the milk is sold through a vending machine. Dispensing milk through a vending machine does not entitle the vender to charge a price higher than permitted by the regulations.

In keeping with President Nixon's statement of January 11, 1973, concerning controls on food prices John E. Foley, District Director of the Internal Revenue Service announced that an investigation has begun to determine if the dramatic rise in milk prices is justified under the law. Violation of the law can result in a fine of up to \$5,000 for each infraction.
