Upon reading and filing the Petition of Bruce Allan Vinal verified the 15th day of March, 1973, for leave to change the name of petitioner, and it appearing that petitioner was born on June 10th, 1933 at Buffalo, New York and that the certificate of petitioner's birth issued by the New York State Department of Health bears No. 37206 and was issued from Buffalo, New York under local registration number 4514; that petitioner has fulfilled his military obligation and United States Selective Service Act obligation under the name Bruce Allen Deming; and the Court being satisfied that said petition is true and that there is no reasonable objection to the change of name proposed.

NOW, ON MOTION OF Williams & Sprague, Attorneys for the Petitioner, it is,
 ORDERED that said Bruce Allan Vinal be and he is hereby authorized to assume the name of Bruce Allen Deming in the place and stead of Bruce Allan Vinal on first day of June, 1973 upon complying with the provisions of Article 6 of the Civil Rights Law, and of this Order; namely, that this Order be entered and the papers upon which it is being granted be filed in the office of the Clerk of this Court within ten days from the date hereof; that within twenty days from the date of the entry of this Order a copy thereof be published once in the Andover News, a newspaper, published in Andover in Allegany County; that the Affidavit of Publication thereof be filed in the office of the Clerk of this Court within forty days after the making of this Order; and that the serving of notice of change of name upon the chairman of the local selective Service Board be, and it hereby dispensed with as petitioner has fulfilled the requirements of the Selective Service Act under the name Bruce Allen Deming, and it is further,

ORDERED that after such requirements are complied with said petitioner on and after June 1, 1973 shall be known as and by the name of BRUCE ALLEN DEMING which petitioner is hereby authorized to assume and by no other name.
