Legal Notice

Local Law No. 3

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Local Law No. 3 of 1973 which became effective March 14, 1973, is published pursuant to Section 214 (2) of the County Law:

A local law to amend local law number four of nineteen hunred seventy-one, entitled "A local law to provide for a partial tax exemption of real property owned by certain persons with limited income who are sixty-five years of age or over", in relation to income eligibility requirement.

BE IT ENACTED by the board of legislators of the county of Allegany as follows:

Section 1. Subdivision b of section two of local law number four of nineteen hundred seventyone, is hereby amended to read as

one, is never follows:

b. The income of the owner or the combined income of the combined income of owners or the combined income of husband and wife where title is vested in either the husband or wife must not exceed three thousand six hundred dollars for the income tax year immediately pre-ceding the date that the application is filed.
