Kalvin Shaw recorded the win as he went the full 1 Innings, allowing 8 scattered hits, striking-out 8, and walking just 2.

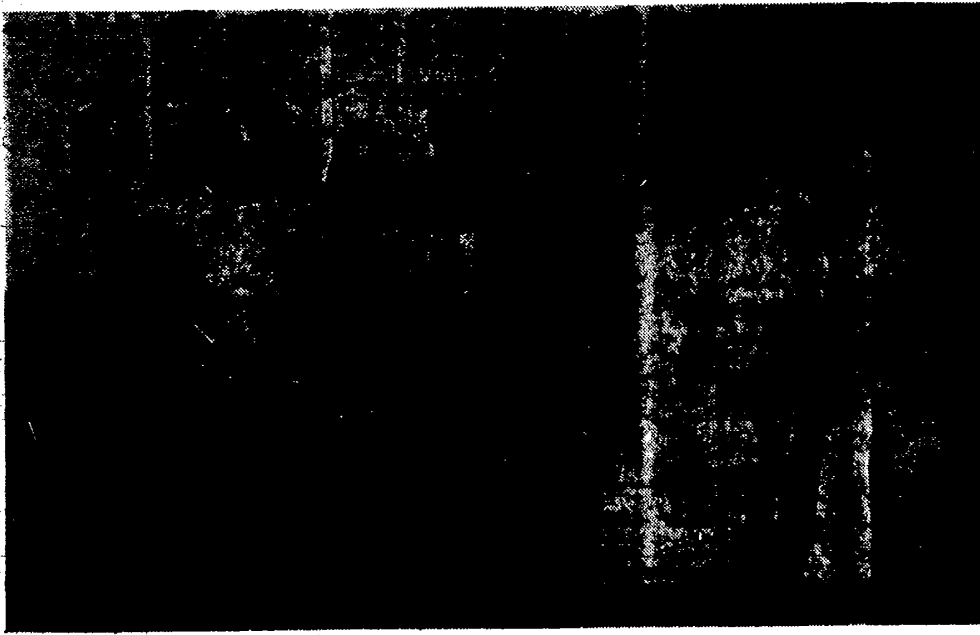
