Calcium Is Not Just For Kids

Calcium is more than a builder of bones and teeth in growing children. This mineral - which makes up about 2 per cent of the weight of the average adult - also acts as a body regulator, helping in the contraction of muscles, excitation of nerves, clotting of blood, and maintenance of healthy bones.

While nutritionists differ on the precise amount of calcium needed daily by adults, the recommended daily allowances suggested by the Food and Nutrition Board of the National Academy of Sciences-National Research Council have gained widespread acceptance.

According to these recommendations, the average adult should consume about 8 gram each day. This is approximately equivalent to the amount of calcium in three eight-ounce glasses of milk (1.15 grams per quart).

Milk and milk products provide about 75 per cent of the calcium in our food supply. What this means is that it would be highly impractical to get the recommended daily amount of calcium without milk. To get adequate calcium from other foods would mean consuming unusually large quantities.

Studies by the Agricultural Research Service of the U. S. Department of Agriculture have shown that about 30 per cent of American households are not getting the recommended amount of calcium, and that adult women and adolescent girls are most likely to have calcium-deficient diets.
