the vocational rehabilitation program of the VA. Generally, wartime disabled veterans are eligible

severity of the disability, they may
receive up to four years or its
equivalent of training. A veteran
in the program full-time can receive financial assistance of \$170
monthly. If he has one dependent, he can receive \$211, with
\$248.
