NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a public hearing will be held on October 9, 1973 at 1:30 o'clock P. M. in the County Legislators' Chambers, County Courthouse, Belmont, New York, in relation to a proposed Local Law which will establish on January 1, 1974 the annual salaries of certain county officers, to wit: County Judge - \$31,000.00, Commissioner of Social Services - \$15,180.00, Director of Planning - \$14,500.00, County Superintendent of Highways - \$14,500.00; and will also establish on said date the compensation for County Coroners at the rate of \$35.00 per diem in the performance of their official duties. If adopted, the Local Law will take effect on the date it is filed in the office of the secretary of state.

Veterans News

LISTEN VETERAN NOT CUT OUT TO BE A DOCTOR, lawyer, scientist, or other highly skilled professional? Don't fret about it - there is a good opportunity for you in any one of the many courses available at community, technical and agricultural college. One and two year specialized courses in agricultural, construction, drafting, mechanics, graphics, insurance, tool and machine design, business, nursing, and other trades, occupations and professions can provide the training necessary for you to qualify. If you're a Vietnam era veteran, you can get this training with financial assistance under the GI Bill. It pays you \$220 monthly while in training. With one dependent, you can get \$261 and with two its \$298. Got more dependents? Then you can get an extra \$18 monthly for each additional dependent. So what's stopping you from getting that training and going on to a better job?

INDEPENDENCE is the goal of the vocational rehabilitation program of the VA. Generally, war-time disabled veterans are eligible for assistance in overcoming their service-connected handicaps so they can lead useful and productive lives. Depending upon the severity of the disability, they may receive up to four years or its equivalent of training. A veteran in the program full-time can receive financial assistance of \$170 monthly. If he has one dependent, he can receive \$211, with two dependents, \$248, with \$18 more provided for each additional dependent. Veterans in training part-time receive proportionately reduced amounts.
