LOCAL LAW

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the following Local Law is published pursuant to Section 214 (2) of the County Law:

A LOCAL LAW ESTABLISHING THE ANNUAL SALARIES OF CERTAIN COUNTY OFFICERS AND THE PER DIEM RATE OF COMPENSATION FOR CORONERS

BE IT ENACTED by the Board of Legislators of the County of Allegany as follows:

SECTION 1. The annual salary of the County Judge shall be the sum of Thirty-One Thousand Dollars (\$31,000.00).

§ 2. The annual salary of the Commissioner of Social Services shall be the sum of Fifteen Thousand and One Hundred and Eighty Dollars (\$15,180.00).

§ 3. The annual salary of the Director of Planning shall be the sum of Fourteen Thousand Two Hundred and Fifty Dollars (\$14,250.00).

§ 4. The annual salary of the County Superintendent of Highways shall be the sum of Fourteen Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$14,500.00).

§ 5. The compensation for County Coroners shall be at the rate of Thirty-Five Dollars (\$35.00) per diem in the performance of their official duties.

§ 6. This local law shall take effect on the date it is filed in the office of the secretary of state.

A LOCAL LAW AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY OF ALLEGANY TO JOIN THE WESTERN REGIONAL OFF-TRACK BETTING CORPORATION.

Be it enacted by the board of legislators of the county of Allegany as follows:

Section 1 Pursuant to chapter three hundred forty-six of the laws of nineteen hundred seventy-three of the state of New York the county of Allegany hereby elects to join the Western regional off-track betting corporation.

§ 2. This local law subject to a permissive referendum pursuant to the municipal home rule law shall take effect on the date it is filed in the office of the secretary of state of the state of New York.
