Any business place or individual wishing to redeem their wooden nickels may do so at Sesqui-Centennial Headquarters thru August 15, 1974. However, it is expected that these nickels will be souvenir pieces for local people and also former residents coming back for the Sesqui-Centennial during the Celebration Week of August 11 thru August 17, 1974.

The Sesqui-Centennial Committee has had these wooden nickels struck off in five different colors and everyone will want a complete set to keep as a souvenir of this 150th Birthday Anniversary of the Town and Village of Andover. It is suggested that you get your set early as the initial order has been set at a limited number. These Wooden Nickels sent to old friends and relatives will be appreciated in many years to come.

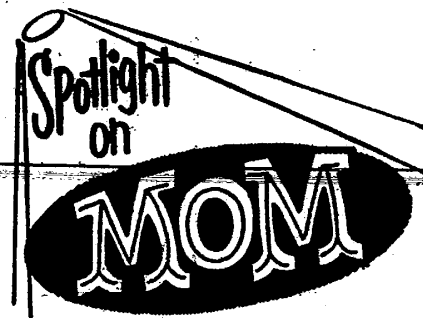
Thru a mutual agreement, Dillie Service & Supply Co., has acquired the refuse removal route from C & M Sanitation Co., of Andover.
