Veterans News

GOVERNOR MALCOLM WILSON has approved legislation allowing Viet Nam veterans the opportunity to compete for a Regents War Service Scholarship. The six hundred scholarships to be awarded state wide, may be used in addition to any other veterans educational benefits. The examination is scheduled for Tuesday, July 9th at examination centers in Albany, Binghamton, Buffalo, New York, Rochester and Syracuse. To be eligible, a veteran must have been a resident of New York State when he entered the Armed Forces and be a resident at the time of application. He must also have served on active duty in the Armed Forces of the United States, for purposes other than training, between October 1, 1961 and March 29, 1973 and released under honorable conditions. Applications for the exam are now available at the local counseling center of New York State Division of Veterans Affairs located at the Municipal Bldg., Wellsville, N. Y., on Tuesdays, and at the City Bldg., 106 Broadway, Hornell, N. Y., on Mondays, Wednesdays, Thursdays and Fridays.

WHAT'S THE DIFFERENCE? — When it comes to pension and compensation there is a difference. Compensation is paid to a veteran to help compensate him for service-incurred injuries. On the other

hand, pension is paid to permanently and totally disabled veterans for disabilities not traceable to war-time service. Both may be payable to veterans survivors. However, pensions which are based

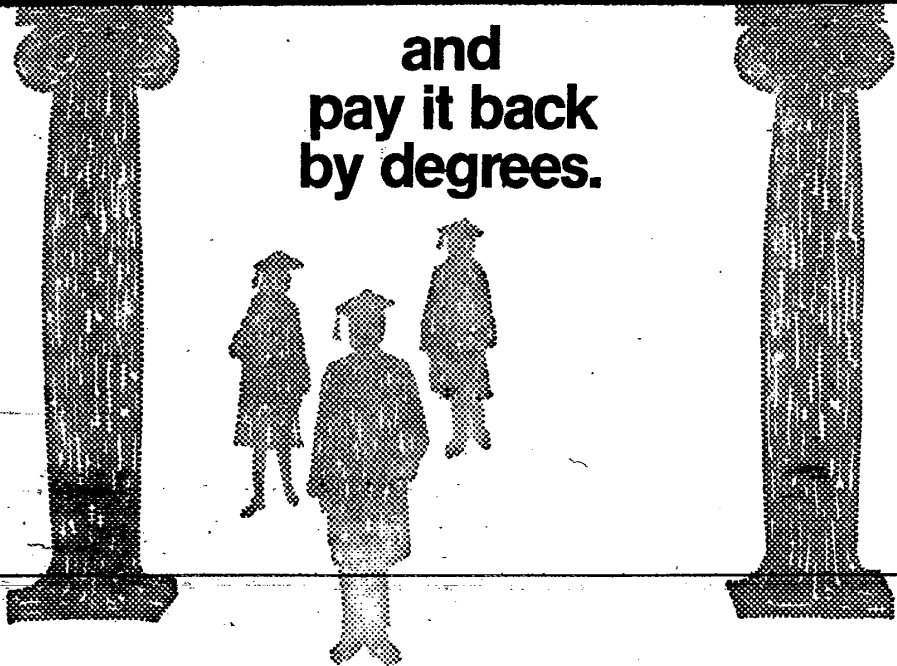
