HOLLAND HOSTS BOY SCOUTS

Holland International Speedway in its annual recognition of the Boy Scouts of Western New York will hold the first of two Boy Scout nights at Holland International Speedway in Holland, New York. This Saturday, August 17th over 1500 Boy Scouts with their counselors will be guests at the speedway to enjoy the full program of auto racing.

With the development of the Challenger Division, the Speedway is now running four full divisions each Saturday night. The 15 plus events on the race program provide for plenty of competition and action throughout the entire evening.

Both Boyle and Dave Barsing of Elma are not far off the pace in attempting to dethrone Hill the current reigning champion.
