Dept. of Environmental Conservation To Hold Public Hearing

A public hearing to review the classification of the Allegheny River and all streams, lakes, ponds and their tributaries in the Allegheny River drainage basin in New York State will be held by the Department of Environmental Conservation next month.

The hearing will be conducted in the Cattaraugus County Office Building in Little Valley at 10:00 a. m., on September 10 and September 11.

Individuals, organizations and municipalities desiring to have reclassifications of a particular body of water considered should advise John McMahon at the regional office of the Department, 584 Delaware Avenue, Buffalo, in writing. This notification should describe the waters for which reclassification is proposed, the classification desired and the justification for the requested change.
