Higher costs of production and labor are reflected in the US Department of Agriculture's September price reports. All 21 fruits listed are sharply higher than last year. And, of the 16 vegetables listed, only cabbage, cucumbers, lettuce and spinach show lower prices. The parity price on potatoes has jumped over \$1/5 per cwt., during the month so, if you run across any at the recent low price — better take advantage of it.

Lettuce demand is slow to fair and prices declined early this week, however, locally, lettuce is rather dirty due to the fact that it was raised in the muck fields.

In the staples field, canned soups are being featured — so now is the time to stock up.

In the meat line pork is being featured this week at attractive prices. And, in the sea food line, fresh oysters are now available although prices are higher than last year.

### Cuba Cheese Co. To Double Output

The Cuba Cheese and Trading Company, Inc. and the Allegany County Industrial Development Agency recently completed financial arrangements for a 1.2 million dollar expansion of the cheese manufacturer's production facilities at Cuba, New York.

The expansion will increase the firm's production capacities by as much as one hundred percent. Cuba Cheese and Trading Company is one of the major markets for much of the milk produced in Allegany County. The increased capacity of the cheese plant facility will allow the company to continue to support the dairy industry of Allegany County by a continued market for milk produced in the county. Milk producing is one of the major industries in the county.

While there will be little increase in employment at the Cuba plant at this time, the increased capacity and improved efficiencies resulting from the expansion will help the Cuba Cheese Company remain competitive in the dairy products market and make it feasible for the company to remain as a major employer in Allegany County.

The Industrial Development Agency is providing one million dollars of the total project cost thru the issuance of industrial revenue bonds. The bonds are being pur-

chased by area banks, with The Citizens National Bank and Trust Company, Wellsville, serving as one of the bond purchasers and trustee for the purchasing disposition. The other purchasers are the First Trust Union Bank of Wellsville, the Exchange National Bank of Olean and Manufacturers Hanover Western N. A., Olean.

The bond closing, the first for the Allegany County agency, was held at the offices of The Citizens National Bank, Wellsville. Announcement of the project was made simultaneously from the Company's headquarters in Cuba.

The Cuba Cheese and Trading Company was established in 1943 as a result of the merger of two other cheese companies. Principal officers of the firm today are Edwin S. Moses, president, and Nico VanZwanenberg, vice president; both reside in Cuba.

The company produces a variety of New York State cheddar cheeses and is responsible for a significant portion of the total production of cheese in New York State. It was a pioneering company in developing dried whey as a marketable commodity, now widely consumed as an ingredient in dairy products. Previously, whey had been largely an unwanted by-product that created very offensive pollution problems.

### Bids To Open On Allegany County Road

Assemblyman James L. Emery, 40, Geneseo announced today that the New York State Department of Transportation will open bids on an Allegany County Road in Albany on October 31.

Assemblyman Emery said that Commissioner Raymond Schuler notified him that the project in Allegany Co. will be the restoration of pavements and slopes at four sites on Routes 19, 243 and 305 in the Towns of Canadea and Belfast. Slopes and a stream bed will be stabilized with stone fill and riprap and pavements will be rebuilt with asphalt in the areas of rain damage. The sites are on Route 243 just east of the Rushford-Canadea Line and 1.5 miles east of the line on Route 19 a quarter — mile south of the Village of Belfast and on route 305 about 4.5 miles southwest of the village. Work areas range from 400 to 1,200 feet in length.

The bids which will be publicly opened on the above date at 10:30 A.M., are part of a total of 24 highway and bridge projects opened state wide. Funds for these projects, according to Assemblyman Emery, were made available in the 1974 State budget.
