discharged under other than dishonorable conditions who: (a) Had
wartime service, or (b) Had Mexican. Borden Service Junuary
1911 to April 5. 1917, or (c) II
peacetime served at least one enlistment, or (d) Was released from
active service because of disability
incurred in or aggravated in line incurred in or aggravated in line of duty, or (e) Had service subsequent to January 31, 1955.

IT'S A FACT - The purchase of a mobile home under the GI Home Loan Program does not prevent a veteran from obtaining a mortgage for a conventional home at a later date, the mobile home loan, now-ever must be paid in full before the new mortgage can be granted.


