A LOCAL LAW ESTABLISHING THE ANNUAL SALARIES OF CERTAIN COUNTY OFFICERS

BE IT ENACTED by the Board of Legislators of the County of Allegany as follows:

Section 1. The annual salaries, none of which include any earned longevity increment, of the incumbents of the county offices herein set forth shall be the amount herein set forth opposite each such office, to wit:
