Good Forest Practices Rewarded

New York State forest owners can improve their forest land, make a profit, and at the same time help alleviate the current shortage of fiber, advises a member of the New York State Forest Practice Board.

Speaking at the Forest Owners' School held recently at the N. Y. State College of Agriculture and Life Sciences, Cornell University, Francis A. (Mike) Demeree described the Forestry Incentive Program, which was designed to encourage better forest management by private forest landowners.

Funded by the federal government and administered by the county Agricultural Stabilization and Conservation Service (ASCS) offices, the program provides for cost sharing for accepted forest management practices.

The government will pay 75 per cent of the landowner's cost for tree planting, thinning, cull removal, forest road stabilization, & the topping of competing trees, he said.

To apply for this cost sharing program, the landowner must file his plan and get approval from his county ASCS office. The area to be worked will be inspected by one of the state's 60 foresters who also lay out the work for the forest owner.

After the work is completed, it is inspected by the forester who notifies the ASCS office of compliance and the proper cost share is remitted to the owner.

Demeree pointed out that as energy and fiber needs become more acute, forest owners and forest management become more important. Fifty-six per cent of the state's land is in forest and about 85 per cent of it is held by some 250,000 owners.

He said, "The manipulation of this resource through various forest practices will allow us to grow more and better usable fiber for an ever-increasing world need."

Pursuant to Section 359 of the County Law, the maximum per diem to be paid during the coming year to members of the Board of Legislators shall not exceed \$50 per day for regular and special meetings and shall not exceed \$25 per day for committee meetings. In addition to the per diem, the Chairman of the Board of Legislators shall receive an annual salary of \$4,500.
