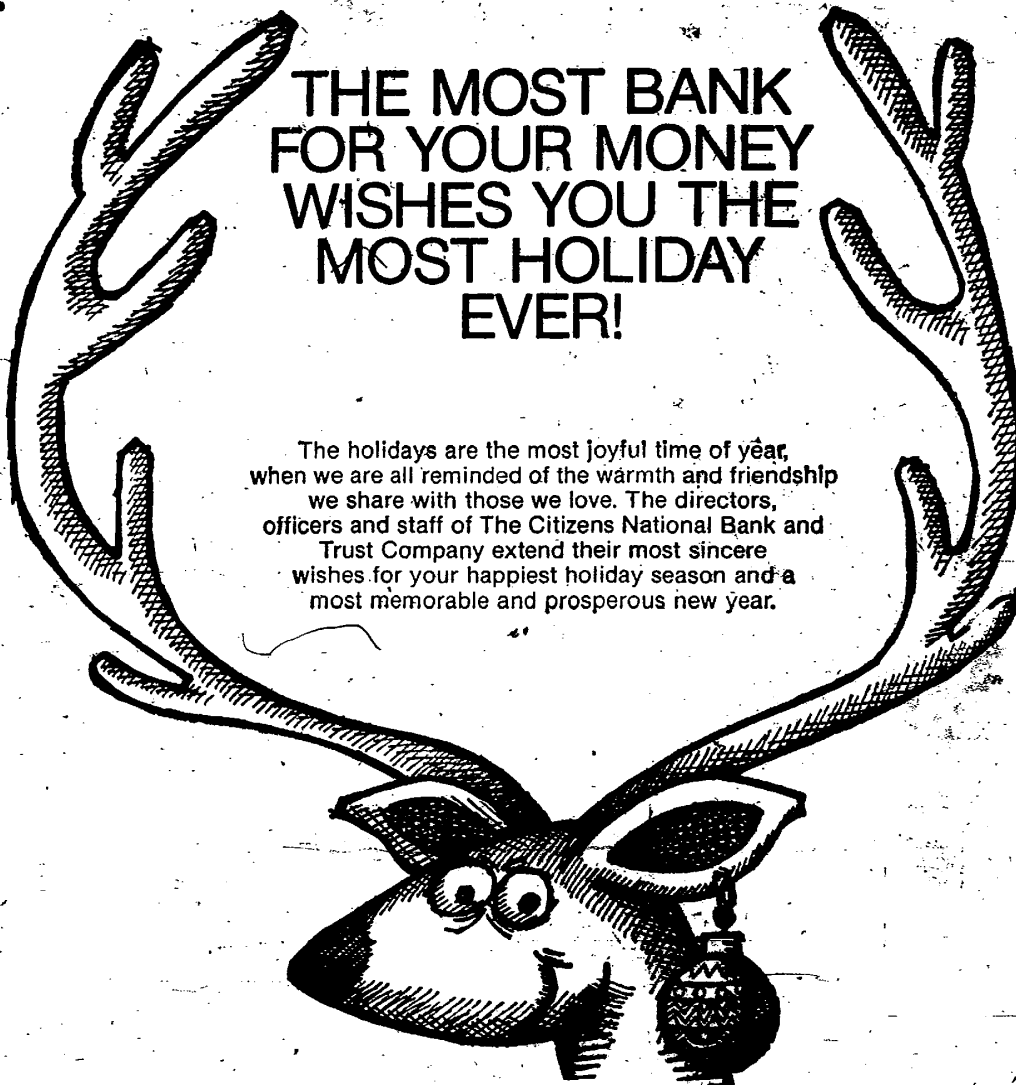
Both Dianne and Cal are professors at Northland College, Ashland, Wisconsin.

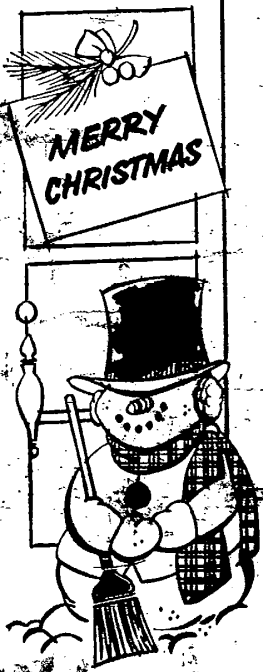
