Notice Of Public Hearing

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a public hearing will be held on January 13, 1975 at 1:30 o'clock P. M. in the County Legislative Chambers, County Courthouse, Belmont, New York, in relation to a proposed local law creating a temporary county commission to study youth programs and services in Allegany County. Said proposed local law, if adopted, will provide that the commission will consist of 17 members, 8 of whom will be under the age of 18 years, to be appointed by and serve at the pleasure of the Chairman of the Board of Legislators; will provide that the commission make a study of youth programs and services in Allegany County; will provide that the commission have power to employ or hire and remove certain personnel and fix their compensation within the amount available therefor by appropriation; will provide that the commission members receive no compensation, but will receive expenses, will provide that the commission be authorized to request and receive from county offices and other municipalities materials necessary to consummate its studies; will provide that the commission may request and receive state and federal aid for undertaking their study; will provide that the commission report to the Board of Legislators its proceedings and recommendations no later than August 1, 1975; and will become law effective immediately. Dated at Belmont, New York the 23rd day of December 1974.

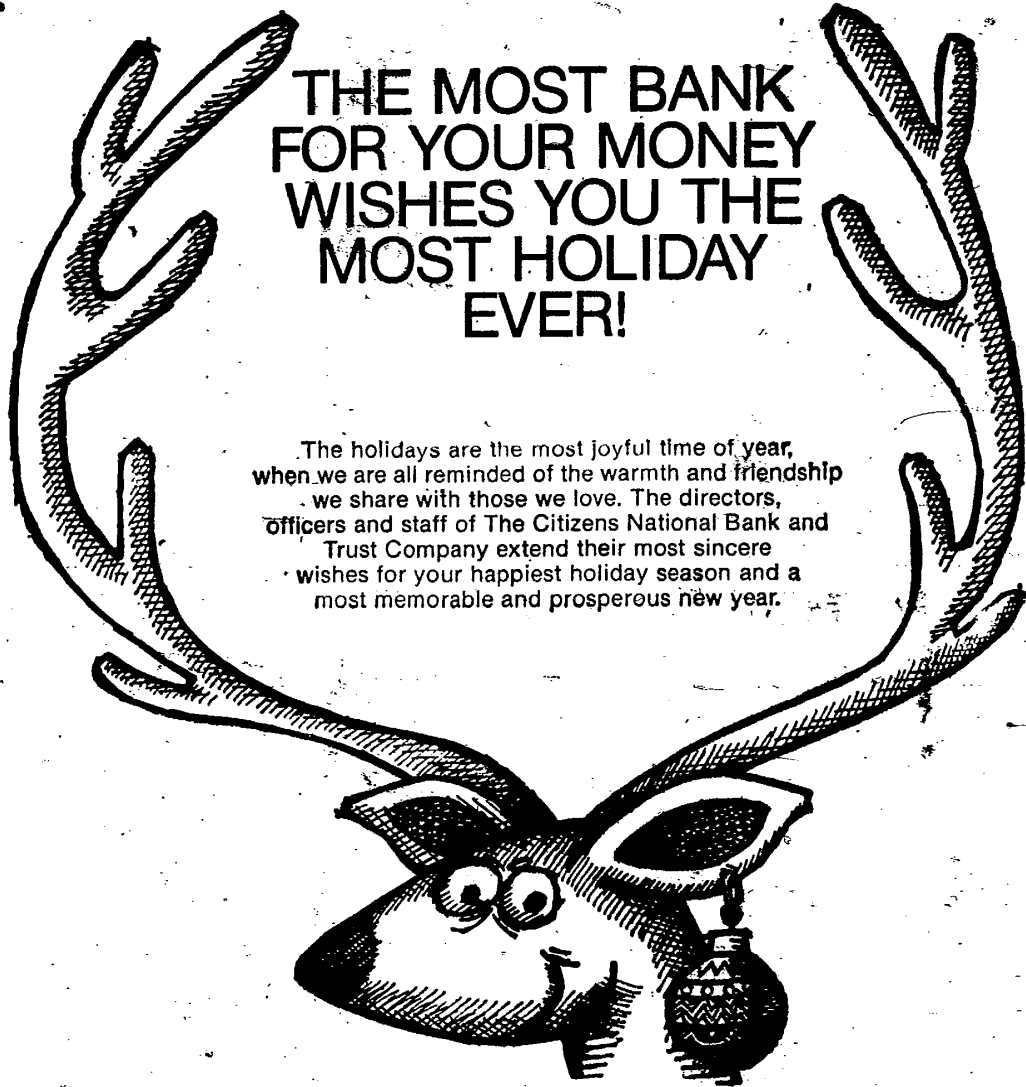
