Hi there Folks! Here is a little "Gem" that we thought most of you would be interested in — one way or another. So, Come on You Cats!!!

The marketing research department of Goldkist, Inc., a farmer's cooperative headquartered in Atlanta, Ga., has come up with the statistic that the nation's 30 million cats require 400,000 Tons of Cat Litter annually — a market purposed to be worth \$80 million.

Goldkist, a processor of peanuts, is stuck each year with a growing mountain of hulls for which some profitable use was sought. Kitty Litter, impregnated with baking soda to inhibit odors, is the cooperative's latest patented brain-storm.

In the Grocery Department, Kraft Mayonnaise is 99c a qt.; Skippy Peanut Butter is 59c for a 1 lb. 2-oz. jar; 7 Farms, Green Beans are 5 — 1-lb. cans for \$1; Red & White, Tomato Soup at 6 — 10 1/2-oz., cans for \$1; Sliced Beets at 4 — 1-lb. cans for \$1; and 7 Farms Ice Cream is 78c for a 1/2 gallon.

In the Produce Department, Iceberg Lettuce is 29c a head; Carrots are 29c for a 2-lb. pkg.; Mushrooms are 99c a lb.; Florida Oranges are 79c for a 5-lb. bag; and Florida Grapefruit is 89c for a 5-lb. bag of either the Red or Whites.

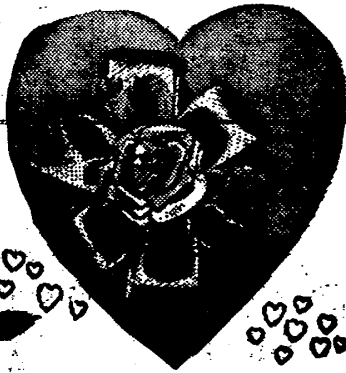
