Thursday, March 13, we were privileged to have guest speakers Mr. Paul King, Jacob and Solomon ... The boys are staying at Arkport New York.

Paul King is from Alfred. He started working with the immigrants two years ago at Genesee State College. He realized how the Indians are being neglected and he wanted to do something about it.

Jacob 19 and Solomon 17 are Algonquin Indians from North West Quebec.

Mr. King, Jacob and Solomon presented films to Mrs. Debrah Knapp's Junior Social Studies classes. The films covered the cold, hard everyday life of the Indian migrant worker.

Improvements are coming to Rapid Lake. New housing projects, washing machines, and medical care are among some of the main improvements.

Children are growing up without medical and dental care with the exception of a dentist once a year. The people grow old fast under the harsh working and living conditions, but now the Indians have a better chance.

The women run the household jobs. The men work out doors. When the children are old enough they dig a hole in the side of the house, split wood for heat, and hunt for food.

The Algonquin Indians are very skilled. They make some of their crafts for sale, including the traditional ... moccasins, mittens and many other items.
