Hi there Folks! Did you have a good time at the Maple Festival? Enjoyed everything except the cool weather huh. Cheer up — Spring will really get here some day.

One thing that can be reported on is the fact that the sugar market has been unstable for the past four weeks, and could very well drop lower.

For the "Best Buys" this week in the Meat Department, Corn King, Semi-Boneless Ham is \$1.09 a pound; by the half is \$1.19; Irish Brand Semi-Boneless is \$1.29 by the half or whole; and Corn King Boneless is \$1.39. Combination Pork Chops are down to 99c a lb.; Chuck Steak is 69c a lb.; Chuck Roast is 79c; and Round Bone Beef Shoulder Roast is 99c a lb.

In the Grocery Department, Mrs. Filber's Mayonnaise is 76c a quart; Hunt's Ketchup is 3 bottles for \$1.00; Red & White Chicken Noodle or Vegetable Soup is 5 cans for \$1.00; Gold Medal Flour is 69c for a 5-lb. bag; Crisco Oil is 77c for a 1-pt. 8-oz. btl.; and Post 40% Bran Flakes are 69c for a lb. pkg.

In the Produce Department, new Cabbage is 12c a lb.; Pascal Celery is 33c a bunch; Broccoli is 49c a bunch; Mushrooms are 99c for a lb.; and Florida Grapefruit is 5 for \$1.00.

Winners in the racing division were: 1st Brian Baker; 2nd Jerry Joyce and 3rd Mike Joyce.

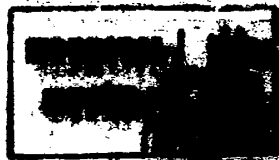
In the judging for quality in workmanship: 1st John O'Hara, 2nd Tim George and 3rd Gary Granger.
