Hi Folks! Do you have your order in to the "Easter Bunny" for all the things you want for Easter?

We are glad that we were able to have Ham on special for over the Easter Holiday and are also happy to report that beef prices should remain steady thru the rest of April. So, now is the time to stock up on beef for your freezer while stocks are plentiful.

For this week's Specials — in the Meat Department—last week's Ham Specials are still in effect thru Easter with Corn King Semi-Boneless Ham at \$1.09 a lb. for the whole ham; and Boneless Ham is \$1.39 a lb. for either a half or whole Ham. In the Beef Line, Ground Chuck is 99c a lb.; and Boneless Chuck Roast is 99c with Fresh Pork Loin Roast at \$1.19 a pound; and the Loin Half Pork Roast at \$1.29 a lb.

In the Grocery Department, Red & White Corn is \$1.00 for 4, 1-lb. 1oz. cans; Blue Boy Peas are 3 — 1 lb. cans for 89c; Red & White Fruit Cocktail is 3 — 1-lb. cans for \$1; Breast of Chicken Tuna is 49c for a 6 1/2-oz. can; 19X or Light Brown Sugar is 69c for a 2-lb. bag; and 7 Farms Ice Cream is 79c for a 1/2 gallon.

In the Produce Department, California Asparagus is 47c a lb.; Fresh Cukes are 2 for 25c; Green Onions are 2 bunches for 25c; Red Radishes are 33c for a lb. pkg.; and Florida Pascal Celery is 33c a bunch.

Well, that just about "wraps it up" so, See Ya around?

Spring Turkey Season Open May 10 - 23

Hunters planning to participate in New York's Spring Turkey hunt May 10 - 23, are reminded by the Department of Environmental Conservation to enclose the required \$2 fee with their turkey permit application. The spring season will open in all or portions of 24 counties with bearded turkeys only fair game. Hours are sunrise to noon.

The \$2 fee required for the spring hunt is entirely separate from the fall hunt and must be submitted whether or not the hunter had a fall permit. Applications for the spring hunt should be made as soon as possible to avoid any last-minute delays. Final date for submitting an application with assurance of receiving a permit by opening day is APRIL 30.

Last spring turkey hunters in New York established a new record, taking 710 bearded turkeys. This compares with the previous high of 590 birds taken during the spring hunt in 1974.

Take for the fall season was 1,181 birds. The record fall take was 1,570 birds reported for the fall 1973 season.
