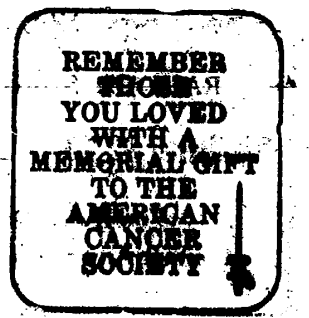
United Speedway News

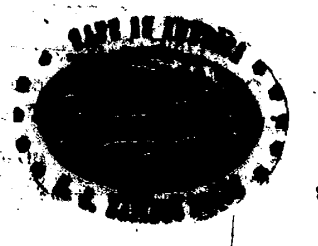
