BOND RESOLUTION DATED MAY 13, 1974.

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF \$100,000 SERIAL BONDS OF THE VILLAGE OF ANDOVER, ALLEGANY COUNTY, NEW YORK, TO PAY THE COST OF THE ACQUISITION AND INSTALLATION OF ADDITIONAL SUBSTATION EQUIPMENT IN THE ELECTRIC DISTRIBUTION SYSTEM OF SAID VILLAGE.

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Andover, Allegany County, New York, as follows.

Section 1. The specific object or purpose of the Village of Andover, Allegany County, New York, for which the serial bonds herein authorized are to be issued is the acquisition and installation of new substation equipment as a part of the electric distribution system of said Village at Maple St., Andover, New York.

Section 2. The maximum estimated cost of the aforesaid specific object or purpose is \$100,000, and the plan for the financing thereof is by the issuance of \$100,000 serial bonds of said Village, hereby authorized to be issued pursuant to the Local Finance Law.

Section 3. The following determinations are hereby made.

- a) The period of probable usefulness applicable to the aforesaid specific object or purpose is thirty years, pursuant to subdivision 5 of paragraph a of Section 11.00 of the Local Finance Law.
- b) The maximum maturity of the serial bonds herein authorized to be issued will exceed five years.
- c) No down payment is required pursuant to the provisions of subdivision 3 (d) of paragraph d of Section 107.00 of the Local Finance Law.

Section 4. The faith and credit of said Village of Andover, Allegany County, New York, are hereby irrevocably pledged to the payment of the principal of and interest on such bonds as the same respectively become due and payable. An annual appropriation shall be made in each year sufficient to pay the principal of and interest on such bonds becoming due and payable in such year. There shall annually be levied on all the taxable real property in said Village a tax sufficient to pay the principal of and interest on such bonds as the same become due and payable.

Section 5. Subject to the provisions of the Local Finance Law, the power to authorize the issuance of and to sell bond anticipation notes in anticipation of the issuance and sale of the serial bonds herein authorized, including renewals of such notes, is hereby delegated to the Village Treasurer, the chief fiscal officer. Such notes shall be of such terms, form and contents, and shall be sold in such manner, as may be prescribed by said Village Treasurer, consistent with the provisions of the Local Finance Law.

Section 6. The validity of such bonds and bond anticipation notes may be contested only if

- 1) Such obligations are authorized for an object or purpose for which said Village is not authorized to expend money, or
- 2) The provisions of law which should be complied with at

the date of publication of this resolution are not substantially complied with, and an action, suit or proceeding contesting such validity is commenced within twenty days after the date of publication, or

3) Such obligations are authorized in violation of the provisions of the Constitution.

Section 7. Upon this resolution taking effect, the same shall be published in full in Andover News, the official newspaper, together with a notice of the Village Clerk is substantially the form provided in Section 81.00 of the Local Finance Law.

Section 8. This resolution is adopted subject to permissive referendum.
