**3rd ANNUAL TRACTOR PULL**  
This Friday, August 6 and this Saturday, August 7, the Perry Center Fire Department will present its Third Annual Tractor Pull at Perry Motor Speedway in Perry, N. Y. The event carries a Western New York Tractor Pull Association sanction.

Total prizes for the weekend are almost \$4,000.00. The classes include various weight levels for Stock, Super Stock, Modified and 4 Wheel Drive Pick-ups. All divisions will participate both Friday and Saturday in the scheduled events.

All pulling will take place under the lights starting at 7:00 p. m., each night. Admission is \$2.50 for adults with children under 10 years of age free.

In addition to the tractor pull, there will be overnight camping available for all spectators and pullers. Guarded overnight parking will be provided for all entrants.

In the event that either night is rained out, Sunday, August 8 will be used as a rain date. Due to the rain date, there will be no auto racing at Perry this weekend. Racing will resume on Sunday, August 15 with the DeWitt Challenge Championship.

**JR. STARTER NIGHT**

Hundreds of checkered flags will be given away to the early arriving youngsters. All children under 12 will then be involved in a Jr. Starter contest with a final determination for the Jr. Starter for the 1977 racing season. The Jr. Starter acts as the assistant to the Chief Starter similar to the bat boy in baseball.

Dick Flagg of Eggertsville in the Late Model Sportsman and Charlie Neumann of Lockport in the Limited Sportsman are attempting to repeat their 1975 conquests.
