Hi Folks! Have you enjoyed the last week of nice summer weather -- without 1 day of rain? Or are you looking for a shower or two now to help the cucumbers along? For this week's specials Beef continues to be the best buy: Chuck Steaks at 59c a lb.; Ground Beef at 79c; Round Bone Shoulder Beef and center cut Chuck Steaks Roasts at 99c; Boneless Round Round Steaks at \$1.29; and Boneless Round Roasts at \$1.39 a lb. Wilson Corn King, all meat Franks are 59c for a 12-oz. pkg.; Sliced Bologna is 89c for a 12-oz. pkg.; Beef Liver is 49c a lb.; and Combination pkgs. of Pork Chops are \$1.09 a lb.

In the Grocery Department Pillsbury Flour is 79c for a 5-lb. bag; Ragu Spaghetti Sauce is 99c a qt.; R & W Ravioli is 39c for a 15-oz. can; R & W Raspberry Preserves are 69c for a 1-lb. 2-oz. jar; Prince Elbow Macaroni is 89c for a 3-lb. box; Hormel Spam Luncheon Meat is 89c for a 12-oz. can; Welch's Grape Jelly is 89c for a 2-lb. jar; and Del Monte Sweet Peas are \$1 for 3 -- 1-lb. 1-oz. cans.
