Hi Folks! Did some one ask us about the future cost of coffee? According to our latest information — it isn't a rosy picture. As of today, the wholesale price of raw coffee beans which has risen daily, is now pegged at \$2.05 per pound. Thus you can figure out for yourselves what coffee will cost when existing stocks are used up and his new crop of coffee

beans is processed.

For the "Specials of the Week" in the Meat Department, Chicken is being featured along with Pork. Family Pack Frying Chickens are 43c a lb., with Pork Butt Roast at 89c, and Pork Butt Steak at 99c a pound; and Smoked Picnics at 79c a pound. In the Beef Line, Center Cut Chuck Roasts are 69c; Ground Chuck is 89c a lb.; Round Bone Shoulder Roasts are \$1.09; Armour Hot Dogs are 89c a lb., and Chunk Bologna is 78c.

In the Grocery Department, Jack Frost Granulated Sugar is 89c for 5 lbs., R & W Saltines are

49c for a 1-lb. box; R & W Graham Crackers 59c a lb.; Robin Hood all purpose Flour is 69c for a 5-lb. bag; Del Monte Peas or Corn is \$1 for 3, 1-lb., 1-oz cans; their Chunk Tuna is 55c for a 6 1/2-oz. can, their Pineapple-Grapefruit Drink is 79c for a 1-qt., 14-oz. can; and their Fruit Cocktail is 89c for 2 1-lb., 1-oz. cans.

In the Produce Department, Bananas are 19c a lb.; Pascal Celery is 29c a bunch. Fresh Cabbage at 10c a lb.; Green Peppers 3 for 39c; Carrots 19c a lb.; and Radishes are 29c a lb.
