As the closing ceremonies of Andover Bicenennial Celebration were underway, I took great pride in the comments that were made by the press that we are in a "unbelievable" and "wow" atmosphere.

As you have probably noted Assemblyman Jesse Emery presented a flag to the Village on behalf of the State commemorating Andover's Celebration. In addition, a scroll was given to the Bicentennial Commission Chairperson, acknowledging the activities.
