Hi Folks! Well, it looks like our nice Fall Weather has "gone with the wind" and with those white flakes floating around, winter can't be far behind.

For the Specials this Week, in the Meat Department, Chicken is being featured with whole Fryers at 39c a lb. In the Beef Line Chuck Roasts are 59c a lb.; Ground Chuck is 89c a lb.; and Shoulder Roasts are 99c. Shoulder Picnics are 79c; Rib End Pork Chops or Pork Roasts are 99c a lb.; Loin End Pork Chops are \$1.09 a lb.; and Center Cut Rib Chops are \$1.39; with Braunschweiger at 69c a lb.; Polish Sausage at 89c and R & W Luncheon Meats at 99c a lb.

In the Grocery Department, the "Trainload Sale of Red & White Canned Goods are still in effect with R & W Tomato Soup 6/\$1; Mushroom or Vegetable Soup 5 for \$1; Fruit Cocktail at 3 cans for \$1; Chunks, Crushed, or Tid Bits of Canned Pineapple are 2 cans for 89c; and Tomato Ketchup is \$1 for 3 - 14-oz. bottles.

In the Produce Department Idaho Potatoes are 99c for a 10 lb bag; Radishes are 29c for a lb pkg.; Green Peppers are 6 for \$1; and Red Emperor or Black Ribier Grapes are 49c a lb.
