Proposals shall be made and received upon the following conditions: Each proposal shall be accompanied by a certified check payable to the order of: The County of Allegany, for a sum equal to ten per centum (10%) of the amount bid, or by a bond with sufficient sureties to be approved by the County Attorney in the sum equal to ten per centum (10%) of the amount bid, such check or bond conditioned that if the proposal is accepted, the successful bidder will enter into a contract for the work, and that he will furnish within fifteen (15) days from the date of the acceptance of the proposal, a performance bond in the amount of the contract, conditioned for the faithful and prompt performance and completion of the work specified in the contract and as required by the Specifications.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the following Local Law No. 2 of 1976 which became effective October 29, 1976, is published pursuant to Section 214 (2) of the County Law:

MERGAL INCENTIVE BOARD A LOCAL LAW IN RELATION TO ESTABLISHING AN INDUSTRIAL AND COMMERCIAL INCENTIVE BOARD

BE IT ENACTED by the Board of Legislators of the County of Allegany as follows:

Section 1. There is hereby established an industrial and commercial incentive board for the county of Allegany pursuant to subdivision eight of section four hundred eighty-five-b of the real property tax law.

Section 2. Such board shall advise the Allegany County Board of Legislators, at such time or times as the Board of Legislators may require, of the exercise of the Board of Legislators' options available pursuant to subdivision seven of section four hundred eighty-five-g of the real property tax law. Such board shall also review the economic conditions of the county of Allegany and make recommendations to the Board of Legislators with respect to actions it deems desirable to improve the economic climate within said county. Such board shall also possess such powers and duties as may be prescribed by the Board of Legislators.

Section 3. Such board shall consist of five members who shall be appointed by and serve at the pleasure of the Board of Legislators. A member shall continue to hold office until his successor is appointed and has qualified. Such board shall select its own chairman and such other officers it desires from its members. The members of such board shall receive no compensation for their services, but shall be entitled to the necessary expenses, including travel expenses, incurred in the discharge of their duties.

Section 4. This local law shall take effect on the date it is filed in the Office of the Secretary of State.
