Home Service Assistants Finish Training Program

The first class of Home Service Assistants have finished their ten week training program at BOCES. This course was developed by the Allegheny County Office for the Aging, and is the first one of its kind in the State.

The goal of the Home Service Assistant is to assist the elderly person with their "every day" type of needs. Long-term in-home care and companionship will enable many older people to remain living independently.

Home Service is an extension of the Home care.

The Health Service Assistant may also work as a caregiver for the frail elderly person who needs a respite for family members who care for the elderly relative. These women will be offering a positive alternative to institutionalization.

The Home Service Assistant BOCES training included: Active Listening, Personal Care, Personal Care, Problem Solving, Decision Making, Home Care, Coping Skills and Crisis Intervention.

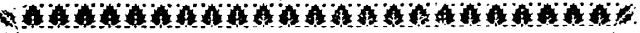
