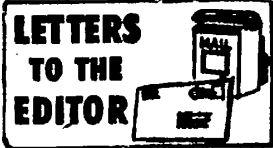
—Mr. and Mrs. Robert C. Spicer of Wellsville spent Monday evening with their parents, Mr. and Mrs. R. E. Spicer.

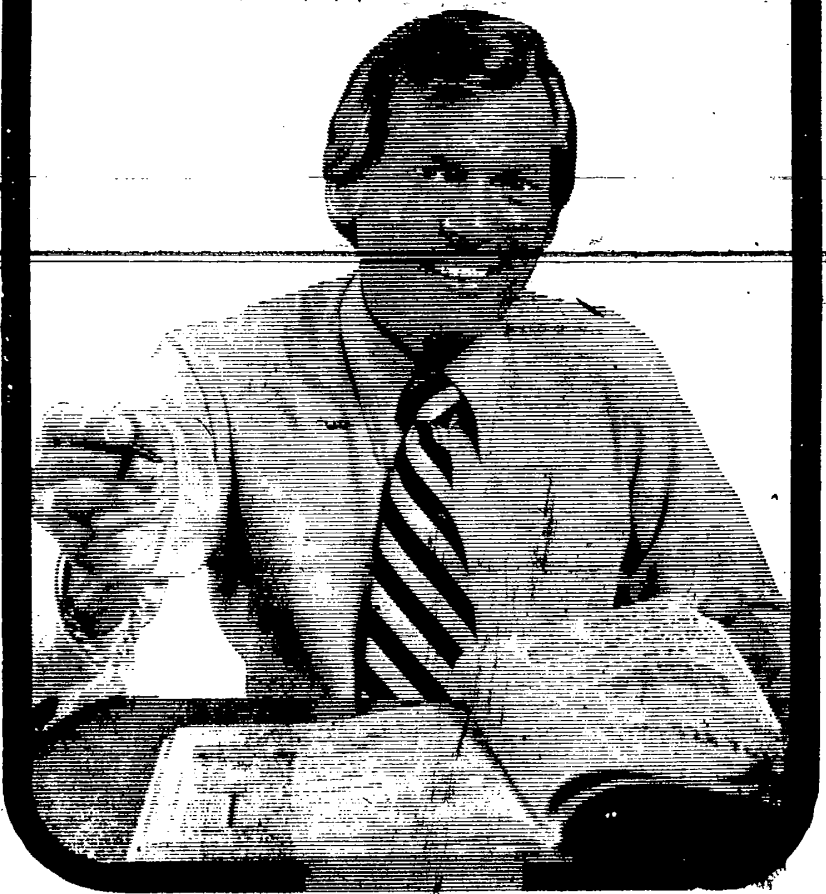
