Republican Primary Thursday Sept. 8, 1977

Sincere there appears to be a certain amount of uncertainty about the forth-coming Republican Primary judging from several Newspaper stories, the following information has been obtained from the Allegany County Election Board.

In Andover on the Town level, Frank Cahill is running against Howard Burdick for Supervisor and Joan Wallace is running against James Haugh for Town Councilman for the vacancy created under the new law whereby a Town Justice can no longer be a Town Councilman after his current term of Office expires.

On the County level, for the position of District Attorney, Incumbent Tom Saunders is opposed by George Francis, For County Sheriff, Royward MacMahon, Larry Ward and Louis Reintner are opposing each other; and for County Legislator from District V, which includes Andover, Lou Burton is running against Mary Orjans. This is mandated by a local law in Allegany County which states in effect that 2 candidates for the same Village cannot run for County Legislator to represent that District.
