After the war, he underwent a protound transformation in his life at the age of twenty when, in a Christian fellowship, he committed his life to Jesus Christ.

One year later, during an evangelistic campaign in 1951, he felt drawn to full-time Christian Set tice. This led him to studies at the Brussels Bible Institute in Belguim. While there he learned of the Christian and Missionary Alli-
